LAUREL GLEN PM 1.97 STORM DAMAGE REPAIR PROJECT

The County of Santa Cruz Department of Public Works has announced that storm damage repairs will commence at post mile 1.97 on Laurel Glen Road, which will be subject to a lane closure and traffic delays. Work can be expected to begin as early as Monday, March 28, 2022, and is expected to last through the middle of July 2022. One lane will be closed, and traffic will be controlled using a temporary signal. This lane closure and delay is necessary for the construction of a soldier pile retaining wall and roadway improvements. The Department of Public Works would like the motoring public to avoid these areas if possible and to expect delays.
